



This transfer plan will help guide you in making the transition from St. Clair College – Windsor, to Wayne State University. Here are some things to keep in mind before you begin:

- No more than **73** credits from St. Clair College – Windsor will apply toward a Wayne State University (WSU) degree. A minimum of **47** credit hours must be completed at WSU.
- We strongly recommend that you see your St. Clair College – Windsor advisor to ensure you are taking the correct courses. We also encourage you to connect with a WSU academic advisor to learn what the path to your degree looks like. General Education Requirements

One of the main areas of focus for transfer students are the WSU **General Education Requirements**. These are classes in addition to courses within your major that are required to ensure fundamental skills and a well-rounded education. St. Clair College - Windsor transfer students can meet these requirements by transferring the courses below, unless noted otherwise, to meet each requirement:

Direct Course Equivalencies for each category:

- Choose **one** from each category **except** for the Natural Scientific Inquiry (NSI), which requires **two** courses. One of the courses must have a lab for 1 credit hour associated with it.
- Each course fulfills only one category.

Only one course is required for each General Education requirement. A partial list of equivalent courses are posted below.
