Course Description and Objective 1 CR Requirements

There are two critical value added activities that are covered via an independent study with Auto Industry Action Group (AIAG) resources made available to us: (a) training sessions provided in conjunction with the Automotive Industry Action Group and (b) and networking and/or conference sessions with automotive industry professionals. The specifics of the directed study for the two components will be designed based on student background.

AIAG training modules: Select a *minimum of three* (up to five can be selected) modules that will be covered in conjunction with AIAG training materials under the supervision of the faculty conducting the directed study. Students must sign up as AIAG student members to take these modules at no cost. The faculty member assigned can assist with this process.

Based on students past experience and interest in customization of practical automotive industry knowledge, students would need to complete a minimum of three training modules (up to five can be taken) in conjunction with the Automotive Industry Action Group. The specific module would depend on the student background. A self-assessment must be available for the module and a copy of the Certificate of Completion should be turned in to the faculty leader of the 1 CR course. Modules available include:
